Australians are facing a wave of laws that will remove our fundamental rights. **Daniel Mackey from 'A Community for Peace & Justice'** will explain how the new laws will overturn our right to freedom of information, freedom of the press, the right to privacy and the presumption of innocence.

He will be joined by **Gerry Moore, member of the National Congress of Australia's First Peoples**, who will discuss changes the Federal Government tried to make to the Racial Discrimination Act that would have allowed comments that offend, insult or humiliate people on the basis of their race. He will explain why the government failed in its attempt recently, and why it is important that we stay vigilant on the issue of racism, using lessons from Australia's history of the treatment of Aboriginal people.

Arthur Rorris, Secretary of the South Coast Labour Council, will discuss the assault on workers' pay and conditions and how the Federal Government is attempting to foster division in our society between those in work and those without, the 'Lifters and the Leaners'. There will be plenty of time for questions, and for discussion about the way forward.
